July 1 GRIFFITH PARK FLAGS- Create a colorful FLAG with GP designs to wave with Old Glory on the 4th of July.

July 8 HOLLYWOOD SIGN- Visit this historic landmark on Mt. Lowe in GP and color your own HOLLYWOOD SIGN at GPGA.

July 15 PARK PAINTINGS – Paint a picture of GP landscape- will it be the Cedar Grove, Ferndell or your favorite picnic place?

July 22 GUITAR TREE- Visit the Beatles, George Harrison Tree, a green oak then collage a tree at GPGA.

July 29 NATURE WEAVING- To honor the Tongva, First People of GP, create a weaving with natural materials.

August 5 SNAKE ON A STICK- Have you seen a gopher, king or rattle snake slithering through GP? Create a replica or fantasy snake with colorful papers and pastels.

August 12 WILD ANIMAL PAINTINGS- Paint a portrait of a bobcat, deer, rabbit, or another animal which roams GP.

August 19 BARK ART- Create a textured collage from fallen tree bark with crawling critter drawings on the surface.

August 26 NATURE WINDSOCK- Construct a colorful windsock with nature drawings to fly through the green acres of GP.

September 2 POSTCARDS FROM THE PARK- Create a special mix media postcard about GP to mail to a friend.
